Which version should I download?

Most software is available in two different versions, only for 64-bit operating systems.

The installer not only installs the software itself, it also installs the drivers necessary for the hardware. The architecture (32-bit or 64-bit) of these drivers needs to match your operating system's architecture. Because official support for 32-bit operating systems ended in October 2025, the software is no longer offered for 32-bit operating systems.

The software itself is still available in a 32-bit version and a 64-bit version. We recommend installing the 64-bit version of the software. However, the 32-bit version functions exactly the same.

The only exception is IVS-PowerPoint. Because it is installed as an Add-In in PowerPoint, the architecture of IVS-PowerPoint must match that of Office. If you installed the 64-bit version of Office, you must also install the 64-bit version of IVS-PowerPoint.

64-bit Windows, 64-bit application

This is the recommended version for most users. The hardware drivers are meant for the 64-bit version of Windows and the application itself is also 64-bit. Please note: **the old, blue keylock is not supported in the 64-bit version**, as no 64-bit version of its driver is available. The new, silver keylock and the temporary license are both supported in this version.

64-bit Windows, 32-bit application

The hardware drivers in this installer are meant for the 64-bit version of Windows. The application itself is 32-bit, as were all previous versions of the software. This version still supports the old blue keylock, as well as the silver keylock and the temporary license.

32-bit Windows, 32-bit application

This version is no longer offered through the website.
